Did you know.....

- 1892 – 1921 The first school in this district was New Era School.
- 1919 - Cadell Settlement
- Jan 23 1922 – Cadell School was in a church hut (Methodist Church), corner Dearden & Heinrich Rds. Enrolment was 23 students. During that year enrolment totaled 58.
- 28 August 1923 – Tenders were called for a new modern public school. Tender was 1239 pounds and construction was completed mid-1924.
- 14 July 1924 – School was officially opened by Hon L Hill, Minister for Education. School was one room (currently library) and housed 40 students. Numbers climbed to 82 students in 1931.
- 1933 – An additional classroom was added, extending the main building to include another classroom (currently staff room). 90 students were enrolled.
- 1974 – Highest enrolment with 115 children.
- 1979 – Opening of school pool.

RAA Road Safety visit

Last Monday we had Christina from the RAA visit and talk to the students about road safety in an interactive format.

The Junior Primary class learnt about different road crossings and road signs. They role - played crossing the road and keeping safe. They were presented with a reflective bag tag.

The Upper Primary Students were told how to be safe when crossing the road 'STOP, LOOK, LISTEN, THINK'. They also identified different road signs and their meanings.

They were given different scenarios and charts and had to identify which was safe and unsafe. Mia and Sayde said that wearing visible clothes whilst out riding your bike or walking was a good option for keeping safe.

They also learnt why jaywalking was dangerous. It was a very informative session.

Each child was presented with lights for their bike.


