Gymnastics

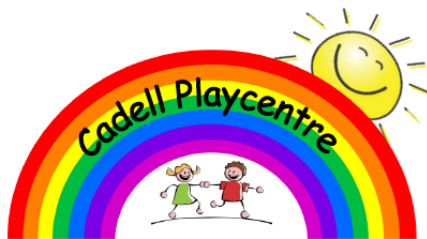
