## Principal's Message

### End of Term

The end of term 3 has come with school being dismissed for the holidays this Friday at 2:30pm. School returns Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October for term 4. ### School Camp

### Children's University

Recently we had the opportunity to join our students up to the Children's University program. <https://www.adelaide.edu.au/childrensuniversity>

The program is designed to support children in thinking about their future and to motivate them to take part in activities in their own time.

Students have the opportunity to work towards various levels of diplomas from Certificate to Fellowships of the University. If they reach the first level 30 hours they will receive their first certificate at an awards ceremony complete with university gowns in Renmark in November.

The University will supply transport for those who need it. Tea will be provided as part of the ceremony. The program is designed to follow them through their schooling. In working toward their diploma they fill in their passport once they have completed learning activities they have visited or taken part in after school, in holidays or in their own lunchtimes etc.

### **External School Review**

Dear parents we have just received the results of our External School Review held earlier this year. The review was very positive and gave us information of what we do well and where to next for our future planning. As a result we received a 4 year return, which means the school won't be reviewed again until 2022.

The 3 recommendations posed to us for improvement include:

1. Streamline learning design, assessment, recording and reporting student learning against individualised student learning plans.
2. Develop and build on the knowledge and understanding of the learning programs offered within the school with the parent community, and how they can work in partnership with the school to engage and stretch the learning of the students.
3. Build on the capacity to design consistent teaching practices that integrate student influence, evidence-based data and learning intentions in a manner that links student learning from reception to year 7.
