Students have the opportunity to work towards various levels of diplomas from Certificate to Fellowships of the University. If they reach the first level 30 hours they will receive their first certificate at an awards ceremony complete with university gowns in Renmark in November. The University will supply transport for those who need it. Tea will be provided as part of the ceremony. The program is designed to follow them through their schooling
